








## Household income in Spokane region, 2005-2011









## Farm Production Balance in Spokane region, 1969-2011

\$44 million loss in production costs










#### Spokane region farm income by type, 1969-2011






































### U.S. Youth Who are Overweight Percent by Age









### Food Bank of North Alabama

- \$159,000 projected sales in 2013 [hurt by rain]






### Incubator farm with packing shed
